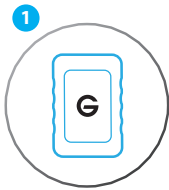


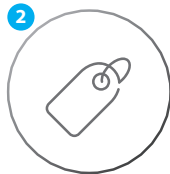

Tips



1 Always carry one more drive than you think you need. This is where a slim drive can be extremely useful. You would rather have the extra storage and not need it, than need it and not have it!



2 Label your drives. When on location, workflow speed is paramount and you never want someone on the crew to be confused about what might be on a particular drive.



3 Upon ingest, I store to the laptop and a G-DRIVE® ev RaW SSD simultaneously. At the end of the day, that gets backed up to a third drive for extra redundancy.
